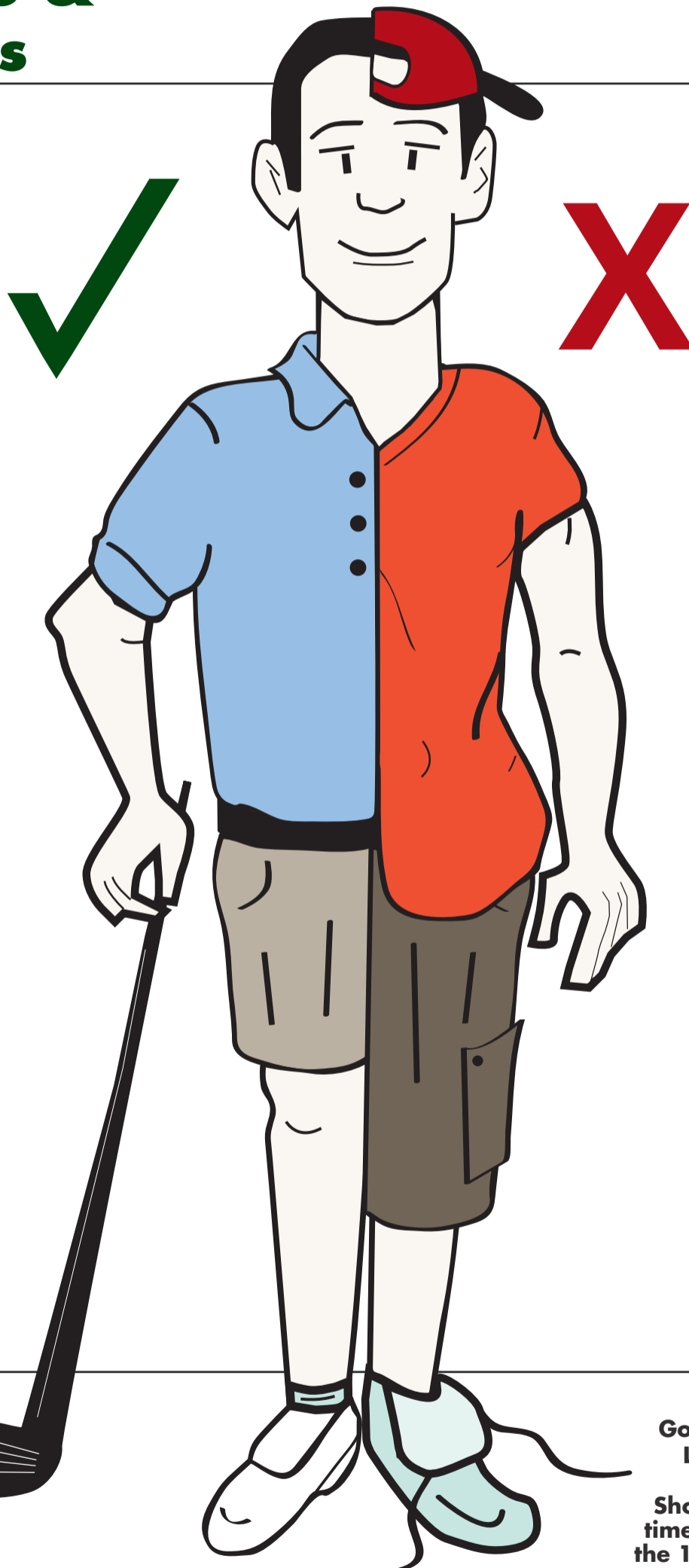
DRESS CODE

On the Course & Practice Areas

April 2011

Appropriate

- **Shirts**
Must be designed for golf, have collars and sleeves and must be tucked in at all times.
- **Trousers**
Must be tailored.
- **Shorts**
Must be tailored and no longer than knee length.
- **Socks**
Must be worn at all times and be clearly visible above the shoe
- **Headwear**
Must be worn as designed with peaks on caps/visors to the front.
- **Shoes**
Must be designed for golf.



Inappropriate

- **Shirts**
Football or rugby style shirts, tracksuits
- **Trousers**
Jeans, tracksuits or cargo style pants
- **Shorts**
Football, swimming, beach, cargo style with side pockets or 3/4 length
- **Shoes**
Training Shoes/ Flip-flops
- **Beachwear**

Clubhouse

Inappropriate

- T-shirts/ Vests
- Denim Jeans
- Tracksuit
- Hats/ Headwear of any kind
- Training Shoes/ Flip-Flops
- Wet weather clothing/ Dirty wet clothing

Golf shoes must NOT be worn in the Lounge, Restaurant or Gallery Bar

Shoes and socks must be worn at all times except on the patio area and in the 19th where socks are not required

All dress should be smart, clean and avoid causing inconvenience or offence to other users so as to maintain the high standard of appearance and behaviour expected from members, their guests and visitors.

Mobile phones may only be used in the car park, changing rooms and foyer or on the course in a medical emergency
